




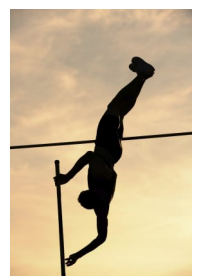

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Within the next few weeks, all Scotland School District students in grades 3-8 and grade 11 will take the online Smarter Balanced Test in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics with the exception of qualifying students with disabilities, who will take the MSAA alternative assessment.

The assessment will be administered over multiple days and will take approximately four hours each for ELA and Mathematics; a total of 7 1/2-8 hours.

Our elementary teachers will determine the dates for testing and will communicate with the parents and students once they have chosen their dates to test.

Please do not schedule appointments during the time period that your child is being tested. It is very important for the students to be here on the day of testing. Make-ups are time consuming for both the administrator and the student. Make-ups are essential because each child must be tested in grades 3-8 and 11. If your child is not here on the test day, it is likely that he/she may have to stay after school, test during a study hall, or test on a Saturday until it is completed.
